



2020-2021 School Year International Tuition and Fee Schedule for New Students

*The above International Tuition rates include the following: Student academic support class three days a week, school yearbook, student newspaper, ASB events, local fieldtrips, ASB card and entry to regular season home sports games.

Application Fee \$150 - One-time fee for new students (includes testing). This fee is non-refundable.

Tuition & I-20 Information Tuition is due in full at the time of enrollment. The I-20 will not be issued until the student is accepted, enrolled and paid in full. At that time, the student must take the I-20 and the acceptance letter to an immigration office to receive permission to attend school in the United States.

If an international student is unable to secure a visa after the tuition has been paid, Tri-City Christian School will refund 92% of the tuition amount. A 8% fee will be retained to cover costs incurred by the school.

Withdrawal Policy: The overhead costs of Tri-City Christian School do not decrease upon withdrawal of students during the school year. All tuition paid for international students is non-refundable.

Convenience Fee 3%	3% charge for each credit card transaction.
Late Fee 5%	Amount assessed for outstanding balances monthly if full payment is not received by the 10 th of the month.
Returned Pymt Fee \$35	Amount assessed for any returned check (a late fee will also be charged for any tuition check received on time and “returned” after the 10 th of the month).
Consumables Included	All students in grades K-6 will receive a school supply list. All students in grades 7-12 are required to purchase consumable workbooks. The fees for these vary by grade level. In addition, students are provided with a set of textbooks which must be returned at the end of the school year. If books are damaged or lost, parents will be charged for repair or replacement when damaged is assessed.
Physical Education \$25	Clothes (shorts and shirt) to be worn for P.E. classes for Grades 7-12. One set is included.
Junior High Athletic Fee (per sport) \$160	For students participating in junior high athletics (this is a participation fee, other expenses will apply).
High School Athletic Fee (per sport) \$250	For students participating in high school athletics other than football (this is a participation fee, other expenses will apply).
High School Football Athletic Fee \$400	For students participating in high school football (this is a participation fee, other expenses will apply).
Field Trips Included	Students visit a variety of local attractions throughout the year. (This includes transportation.)
