High School Parking Information 2017-2018

Student parking at TCCS is a privilege. Students who drive a vehicle to school are required to be licensed by the DMV, insured, and abide by all California Vehicle Code laws, including new driver regulations. Due to limited space, we may not be able to accommodate all students with on-campus parking, in which case, students may have to park off campus. Any student interested in obtaining a parking permit and parking on campus must submit the attached form. Permits will be distributed during the first week of school. Vehicles without permits will not be allowed to park on campus.

- Students are only permitted to park in the main lot, in spaces marked for **students**
- All student drivers must obtain permission prior to returning to their vehicle during the school day.
- Violation of parking regulations (including the 5 mph speed limit) can result in suspension of parking permit.
- All student drivers are prohibited from driving to the Emerald Drive campus without prior authorization.
- SENIORS with off-campus lunch privileges must sign out and in when leaving and returning to campus.
